Dear Homeowners:

Shortly, many of you will receive a Notice of Pendency of Class Action involving a lawsuit which has been filed by Feinberg Grant Mayfield Kaneda & Litt, LLP, in association with Borowsky Law Group, P.C., to recover damages from Del Webb Coventry Homes, Inc. and Pulte Home Corporation (hereinafter "Del Webb/Pulte") for premature failure of the underslab copper water system installed in many homes in the Anthem community. The Court has limited this class action to homes with underslab copper pipe. The class action lawsuit does not include homes with cross-linked polyethylene water supply piping ("PEX"). ***If you do not receive a Notice of Pendency of Class Action, your home was constructed with PEX or KITEC pipe.***

Whether you are affected by the present class action lawsuit depends upon when your home was built and the type of pipe used in your home. In an effort to explain and simplify the information above, I have divided the Anthem homes into two groups as follows:

**Homes with PEX**

If your home has PEX or KITEC pipes, we are not pursuing any legal action against Del Webb/Pulte at this time. We have no information **at this time** that PEX or KITEC pipes are failing prematurely. Therefore, unless new information is brought to our attention by homeowners with PEX or KITEC pipe, we are not taking legal action against Del Webb/Pulte on behalf of homeowners with PEX or KITEC pipes in their homes.

## **Homes with Underslab Copper Pipe**

All homes with underslab copper pipe are included in the class action lawsuit. The class action lawsuit is brought on behalf of homeowners with underslab copper pipe and seeks damages from Del Webb/Pulte for the failure of the pipe. The investigation to date confirms that the hot water underslab copper pipe is failing prematurely due to a process known as thermogalvanic corrosion (“TGC”). This corrosive process, thermogalvanic corrosion, is not resulting in premature failure of the cold water pipes. The goal of the pending class action is to obtain either Del Webb/Pulte’s promise to re-plumb homes that have underslab copper pipe or damages so each homeowner can re-plumb their home.

Class Counsel has petitioned the Court for approval of a formal Notice of Class Action which, upon the Court’s approval, will be mailed to each Class member. In the interim, if you believe your home suffers from the conditions associated with TGC, you are encouraged to contact counsel undersigned. It is Class Counsel’s understanding that numerous homeowners have attempted to obtain the requisite repairs directly from Del Webb/Pulte but have been unsuccessful. In the event you have previously contacted Del Webb/Pulte for this condition or any other, we encourage you to communicate details of your experience to our offices.

This website will provide general information and will be updated as this case progresses. Our goal is to bring this matter to conclusion as soon as practicable; we estimate this time frame to be between 18-24 months. However, litigation is unpredictable and the actual time to conclude the lawsuit may be shorter or longer.

We look forward to providing Class members with an effective and efficient resolution to the plumbing problems in Anthem described above.
